## Gariblonde Blond Ale

Inspired by the bright Garibaldi swimming Catalina's shore, this smooth, sweet and crisp blond ale boldly shines. This blond is made with pilsner, Vienna and two row malts and crystal hops.



## Rabid Fox Amber Ale

The island fox only lives on the six of the Channel Islands. Inspired by its sweet face and smooth coat, our amber cream ale is made with honey and amber malts and lightly hopped with Cascade. A nice foamy head on your glass and you have a Rabid Fox Amber!



## Island Hop IPA

This hoppy West Coast style IPA uses Citra, Columbus, Cascade, Simcoe and Warrior hops to wet your taste buds.



## Lover's Cove Wheat with Black Sage

Indigenous to the island, the wild black sage shrub peppers the hills above Lover's Cove Bay. This wheat is lightly hopped with Cascade hops and uses white wheat and pale two row, allowing the flavor of the wild black sage to shine.



## Dancing Goat Harbor Porter

This porter combines the two Brew House passions - coffee and beer! The name honors Dancing Goat, the Brew House's favorite coffee roast and one of Catalina Island's magical coves, Goat Harbor. Malty and delicious, this beer uses rich chocolate, black patent and biscuit malts and of course, some Dancing Goat coffee.

This stout pays homage to Catalina Island's signature adult beverage. Combining chocolate malts, creamy lactose, bananas, coffee and spices, this beer brings on the flavors of the Island's most loved blended cocktail.
